




NOAA Ship DAVID STARR JORDAN

NOAA ship David Starr Jordan is a 171 ft. western-rigged stern trawler that conducts mid-water and bottom trawling, long-line sets, plankton tows, oceanographic casts, bottom sample grabs, scuba diving, and visual surveys of marine mammals and seabirds.



Scheduled tours will include short presentations by researchers, displays, sampling equipment, scientific labs, the bridge, flying bridge and living quarters.
